

Fifth Grade Reading Log Grading System:



Students are assigned **120 minutes** of required pleasure reading each week. This can be broken down however your child chooses. For example, they may prefer to do all of their reading over the weekend, or they may decide to read for 20 minutes every evening, for six evenings.

Points for Reading Log:

- Each minute of student reading = 1 point toward the total assignment grade.
- 120 points possible per week
- 1st day late = -30 points
- 2nd day late = -50 points
- No name = -10 points
- If "Total Minutes Read" is not filled in at bottom of form = -2 points.
- ***Summaries are required and are an important skill. Weak summaries will not be accepted.
- Reading Logs turned in without a **parent/caregiver signature** will not be accepted. The teacher will return the reading log to the student and ask for a signature, but the reading log will be considered late and points will be taken off of the student's final grade (-30 for one day late, -50 for two days late).
